HANDOUTS PERMITTED
BY ADULTS ONLY!!!!**

**Please no minors (children less than 12 years of age) on
hand outs as they have difficulty in maintaining pace. All
minors must be Accompanied by an adult.**

THROWING HANDOUTS IS PROHIBITED!!!

Violators will be removed from the parade!

RULES:

1. All walkers should maintain pace on handouts at sides of route. Stay with your unit and keep parade pace. Small children should RIDE in the unit as they tire easily.
2. All riders are to STAY inside the vehicle. NO getting in and out of the vehicle during the parade! This is a safety issue so please help us keep the parade safe!
3. No unit will be longer than 40' – includes vehicle AND trailer and no wider than 18'. No corn heads or semi-trailers permitted. Combines should clear the overhanging banners and wires and be able to make the turn at Main/Market.
ALL IMPLEMENT ENTRIES MUST HAVE ADULT WALKER TO GUIDE UNIT THROUGH PARADE.
4. Semi-Tractors: Short bursts on air horns ONLY!
5. All vehicles: Keep a car length distance between you and the vehicle in front of you.
6. **ALL UNITS SHOULD TURN YOUR LIGHTS ON**
7. Parade route is Main St from South St to Market St, West on Market to Marion and turn NORTH to disburse towards Wabash St. Follow Parade Officials instructions!!!
8. **No Pets on Midway after Parade; pets permitted in parade by Dog Grooming or related business only.**

Parade is September 23rd, Thursday evening at 6:00 PM.

Line-up begins at Main and South Street. Please note that No vehicles north of South Street unless directed by Parade Officials!!! Wheels of Yesteryear Tractor Parade lines up at Main & Cherry at 5:30 PM.

Entry fee is \$65 per unit. You must display your entry card in your right passenger side window.
