ALL units in the parade are admitted by approval of the Bluffton Free Street Fair Association and its designated Parade Chairs and are subject to all Rules and Regulations of said Association.

Minors MUST be accompanied by an adult.

All parade entries should have their name or sponsor visible on their entry. This is required to easily identify you for Parade Personnel and Parade watchers. SIGNS, BANNERS, COLORFUL T-Shirts and COSTUMES are excellent ways to identify your unit.
